Victoria “Vicky” Lynn Browning, age 74 of Bowdon, passed away on July 3, 2023. She was a member of GREA-GAE, Right to Read Director with the State Education Dept. of Georgia Foxfire, Bowdon Women Investment Club, Red Hat Society-Scarlett O'Hatters of West GA (Vice-Queen), Bowdon Zoning Board Appeals Board, author to a text about Cusseta history, Avid supporter of BHS Band and Sports Programs (served as an officer in Bowdon Band Boosters), supporter of Drayton Hall Charleston, SC, National Trust for Historic Preservation former member, Atlanta Botanical Gardens former member, and during the Vietnam War aftermath, she helped Asian immigrants obtain legal citizenship in the Fort Benning, GA, area.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, July 5, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. at the Chapel of Rainwater Funeral Home. Prior to the service, the family will receive friends at the funeral home from 12:00 p.m. till the funeral hour.

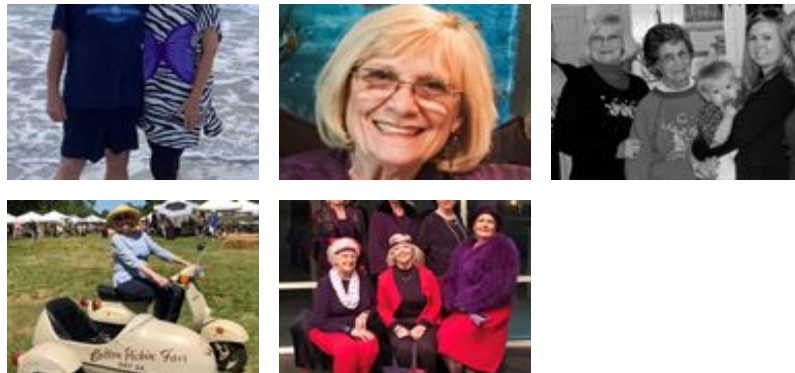
