



## Mrs. Virginia Chambers

November 3, 1929 - December 8, 2024

Mrs. Virginia Chambers, longtime resident of the Victory community in Carroll County, passed away on December 8, 2024. She was 95.

Mrs. Chambers was born on November 3, 1929 in Ambrose, Georgia to the late Monroe and Willie Blanche Dees. She was a graduate of the University of Georgia and received her education degree with a focus in Home Economics. While in Athens, she met her husband, Alvin Chambers, and upon graduation moved with him to his home in Carroll County. Mrs. Chambers was an educator for 40 years and taught Home Economics at Western High School in Sargeant, Georgia and later middle grades science and civics at Roopville Elementary.

Mrs. Chambers enjoyed being an educator and mentor to her students, but she also embraced the job of a ranch wife and worked with her husband managing their cattle farm. She was a longtime member of Victory Methodist Church and also attended Bowdon First Methodist Church. At Victory's monthly services, she would play piano as needed and helped with events and dinners where she was known for her pecan pies. But most of all, she will be remembered by her family for the love given and sacrifices made as a loving wife, mother, and grandmother.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Chambers was preceded in death by her

husband, Alvin Chambers; and her siblings, Howell Dees, Billy Dees, Bonnie Manry, and Johnny Dees.

Survivors include her son and daughter-in-law, George and Candi Chambers of Bowdon, Georgia; her grandson and granddaughter, Kaleb Chambers and Taylor Chambers; her niece, Jane Lanham; her nephew, Allan Deas; and her “angels” and caregivers, Gloria Springer and Marie Realethford.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, December 12, 2024 at 2:00 p.m. at Victory Methodist Church. Rev. Faith Patton will officiate and Mrs. Jane Lanham and Dr. Karen Curtis will offer eulogies. Mrs. Emily Huckeba will render the music. Pallbearers will be Kaleb Chambers, Jett Vise, Rance McWhorter, David Tisinger, Fred O’Neal, Dr. Peter Worthy, Todd Wright, Wayne Johnson, and Jim Rowell. Interment will follow in the church cemetery. Prior to the service, Mrs. Chambers’ body will lie-in-state at the church from 1:00 p.m. till the funeral hour.

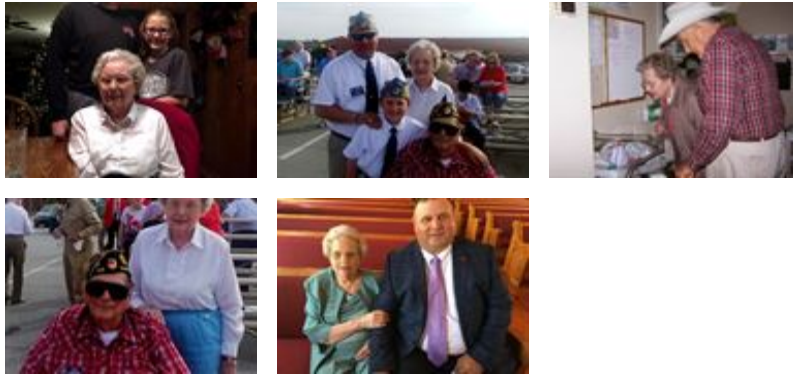
