Mr. Warren Hardin 'W.H.' Lovvorn, of Bowdon, Georgia, passed away on Thursday, March 11, 2010. He was 88.

Mr. Lovvorn was born in the Pine Hill Community of Randolph County, Alabama on December 17, 1921 to the late Thomas Matthew and Ida Traylor Lovvorn. He was a U.S. Navy Veteran of WWII having served in the Pacific Theater. He was retired as a parts manager of Chevrolet and was a member of Pine Hill Christian Church.
